

Tips to Live in a Staged House

- ▼ <u>First Impressions are Key</u> Curb appeal is the most important area to focus on in a house. Keep grass cut, weeds & leaves removed, shrubs and trees trimmed, mulch (black) freshened, garden areas edged, outdoor lighting added and working etc.
- ► Let Your Eyes Be Your Guide walk room by room and try to see for the first time and ask: "What noticed first? Why? Should it be noticed?" There's a principle item in every room...find it and highlight it!
- ► Less is Always More Use the 3 in 3 rule...every 3 months find 3 items that have not been used, touched, etc. and assess what should be done with them. 4Rs apply: reduce, reuse, recycle, repurpose/reinvent
- **▼** The Odd Man is In Symmetry is out...group items in odd numbers (typically 3s)
- ▼ Don't be Afraid of Angles the best way to place furniture in a room is not necessarily to back it up against all the walls and keeping it square...experiment. Think about traffic flow.
- ▼ Anchor Art hang at gallery height 54" from the floor, 6-8" above furniture
- ▼ Think Marilyn Monroe
 Use the right proportions eg. size of furniture, also art above
 furniture should be no more/less than 2/3rds the size (can use more than 1 piece of art to
 achieve the size)
- ▼ <u>Let There be Light</u> natural, artificial, decorative (mirrors, shiny furniture and accessories)



- ▼ <u>Don't Hide your Best Features</u> fireplace, views/windows, staircase, etc. should have minimal items on and in front of them
- ► Layer, Layer mix it up hard and soft, round and square, patterns and solids

 (adds interest and texture to a space)
- ◆ A Place for Everything and everything in its place. Fight the clutter monster. Put things away. Organize, Organize, Organize...closets, bins, cabinets etc.
- ▼ <u>Life is About Balance</u> 60/30/10 major to minor items/colours etc. Unify house colours
- ▼ <u>Keep a Clear Path</u> continuous unobstructed flow from room to room and within a room is key
- ♥ Be Fresh paint regularly, touch up scratches, clean scuff marks windows and carpets
- ▼ <u>Keep it Odor Neutral</u> pets/perfumes/air fresheners/cooking smells/smoke scent free vs. scented
- ▼ Shop the House First Look for items being used in other rooms/for other purposes
 and see it they work better used somewhere else
- ▼ <u>Test Your Way to Success</u> (do not use) but live with tags on purchased items for a few days, see items in different light/at different times then decide to keep
- ▼ Move without Moving rearrange furniture, add new or change accessories with the seasons, add new paint colour...make your old house feel new to you on a regular basis.
- ▼ No Black Holes the garage and basement should not be "indecision" areas for items
- ★ Have Fun Your house should be enjoyed be creative, experiment, play etc.
